



## Mary and Orlin Trapp Science Scholarship Criteria

---

### **Requirements:**

Scholarship awarded to a student who has been a student for at least one full year in Science or Mathematics, including: Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Botany or Zoology.

Scholarship will be awarded primarily on demonstrated outstanding scholarship and a broad range of superior attributes including honesty, high moral character, ethics, integrity, initiative, leadership ability, and concern for community and peers.

Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from faculty members from different departments within the college speaking to above listed values.

Applicant must submit letter verifying church membership from pastor.

First preference to members of a Christian Church, either Protestant or Catholic Church.

Applicant must attend an Iowa United Methodist College or Iowa State University.

Scholarship not based on financial need.

Applicant must submit grade transcript to date.

Applicant must submit proof of ACT and/or SAT test scores.

Applicant must submit Financial Need Analysis, or FAFSA/IRS Tax return.

Applicant personal statement with a history involving the following as applicable:

- Church involvement, positions held and participation in activities.
- Description of leadership in school.
- Community leadership outside the local church.

Three letters of recommendation required:

- Pastor
- School Advisor/Counselor.
- Community Leader outside the local church, i.e. employer, teacher, etc.
