



Arnold W. “Jeff” and Mabel Rensink Endowment Scholarship Criteria

All applications and required documentation must be postmarked by March 1 annually. Late or incomplete applications cannot be accepted by the Foundation so please follow all application requirements carefully.

Requirements:

Awarded annually to an applicant who has a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Applicant must submit a personal statement that describes their call to the ministry.

Applicant must have completed at least a bachelor's degree.

Applicant must be a member of an Iowa United Methodist Church.

Applicant must be enrolled in course of study leading to a graduate or professional level degree at a United Methodist approved seminary.

Preference given to those involved in a church in the following counties: Cerro Gordo, Chickasaw, Floyd, Franklin, Hancock, Hardin, Howard, Kossuth, Mitchell, Winnebago, Worth or Wright.

Applicant must provide transcript to date.

Applicant must submit Financial Need Analysis, or FAFSA/IRS Tax return.

Three letters of recommendation required:

- Pastor.
- School Counselor/Advisor.
- Community Leader, i.e. employer, teacher, etc.

Once you have determined you meet the criteria above please complete the Iowa United Methodist Seminary Scholarship application, checklist and required documents.
