To submit your application, please compile the information in the following order:

- Applicant must complete application specific to Iowa United Methodist Seminary Scholarships.
- Scholarship awarded to a member of an Iowa United Methodist Church or a clergy member of the Iowa Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church.
- Applicant must have completed at least a bachelor's degree.
- Applicant must be enrolled in or preparing to enroll in a course of study leading to a graduate or professional level degree.
- Applicant must attend a seminary approved and recognized by the United Methodist University Senate and/or the United Methodist Board of Higher Education and Ministry.
- Applicant must be recommended in writing by the Pastor-Parish Relations Committee of his/her church.
- First preference is given to an applicant planning to do mission ministry in this country or abroad.
- Preference also given to members of the following United Methodist Churches: Ames Collegiate, Minburn, Nevada, Clarinda, Ottumwa Willard Street and Decorah-Burr Oak.
- Applicant must submit:
 - Financial Need Analysis.
 - Or FAFSA/IRS Tax return.
- Applicant must submit transcript to date.
- Three letters of recommendation required:
 - Pastor.
 - School Counselor.
 - Community leader, i.e. employer, teacher, etc.
