



Dean Fullerton Memorial Scholarship Criteria

Requirements:

Applicant must be a member in good standing of an Iowa United Methodist Church with clear intent on entering Christian ministry.

Applicant must have completed at least the first year of seminary studies.

First preference given to students at Garrett Evangelical Theological Seminary.

Second preference given to students at St. Paul School of Theology.

Further preference given to students planning to return to Iowa to serve in professional ministry.

Applicant shall provide a letter of recommendation from an academic professor of their undergraduate college or university or seminary.

Applicant shall provide letter of recommendation from a local Church leader and active member, outside of Pastor from Church holding applicant's membership.

Applicant shall provide a narrative of their personal journey and call to ministry and involvement in the Church and wider Christian community.

Applicant must provide transcript to date.

Applicant must provide proof of ACT and/or SAT test scores.

Applicant must submit Financial Need Analysis, or FAFSA/IRS Tax return.

Applicant personal statement with a history involving the following as applicable:

- Church involvement, positions held and participation in activities.
- Description of leadership in school.
- Community leadership outside the local church.

Three letters of recommendation required:

- Pastor.
- School Advisor/Counselor.
- Community Leader outside the local church, i.e. employer, teacher, etc.
