



## E. Lorraine Campney Memorial Scholarship Fund Criteria

---

### **Requirements:**

Applicant must have completed at least a bachelor's degree and be enrolled in or planning to enroll in a course of study leading to a graduate or professional level degree in preparation for full-time Christian service.

First preference is given to applicants from the Burt, Iowa community; (regardless of religious preference or affiliation). Second Preference goes to members of the United Methodist Church in the following counties: Buena Vista, Clay, Dickenson, Emmet, Lyon, O'Brien, Osceola, Palo Alto, Pocahontas, and Sioux.

Applicant shall provide letter of recommendation from a local Church leader and active member, outside of Pastor from Church holding applicant's membership.

Applicant shall provide a narrative of their personal journey and call to ministry and involvement in the Church and wider Christian community.

Applicant must provide transcript to date.

Applicant must provide proof of ACT and/or SAT test scores.

Applicant must submit Financial Need Analysis, or FAFSA/IRS Tax return.

Applicant personal statement with a history involving the following as applicable:

- Church involvement, positions held and participation in activities.
- Description of leadership in school.
- Community leadership outside the local church.

Three letters of recommendation required:

- Pastor.
- School Advisor/Counselor.
- Community Leader outside the local church, i.e. employer, teacher, etc.
