

- 1. **Explore new technology**—Create an immersive worship experience with new lighting, sound and video systems.
- 2. Make the church building more handicap accessible—Adding accessible parking spaces, ramps at entrances & exits, elevators, accessible toilets, and braille signage will make individuals with disabilities feel more welcome.

- 4. **Create children's space**—Investing in quality areas for children reflects that your church puts value on family.
- 5. Build space for things other than worship
- 6. **Make an overall good impression**—Keep your church well-maintained so that new guests and members feel as if it is a clean and inviting place to come. Some updates could include landscaping, painting, new roofing, new flooring, and restroom updates.

Q: What types of loans, terms, and rates does the Foundation offer?

A: We offer construction and renovation loans with terms up to one year. Short-term, unsecured loans starting at \$5,000 and less than \$50,000 are offered upon board approval. We also offer permanent loans with an amortization of up to 15 years with a five-year rate reset. Call us for more information about our competitive loan rates!

Q: What types of projects can our church borrow money for?

A: We understand that not every church has the same financial needs, which is why the Trust provides a wide array of loans. Some examples include: construction of new buildings, renovations or additions to existing facilities, the buying of land or a parsonage, ministry expansions, multimedia updates, appliance or technology upgrades, and the refinancing of an existing loan.

Q: What sets the Foundation apart from other lending institutions?

A: Our loans are generally less restrictive with lower costs than other lenders and are more flexible with terms. We also only make loans to churches and church-related entities and understand church needs and finances better.

- 4. The Trustees of the Building Fund Trust will conduct a loan review and notify the church on their decision

*All loans will have no prepayment penalties and will be non-assumable by other parties. The borrower is responsible for all closing costs, legal fees, filing fees, etc. The borrower must also provide an updated abstract to the Trust.
