

## Mary and Orlin Trapp Science Scholarship Criteria

## **Requirements:**

Preference to members of a Christian Church, either Protestant or Catholic Church.
Applicant must be a student who has been in college for at least <u>one full year</u> in
Science or Mathematics, including: Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Botany or Zoology.
Applicant must attend an Iowa United Methodist College, Iowa State University,
University of Iowa or University of Northern Iowa.
Applicant must submit a college transcript to date.
Scholarship will be awarded primarily on demonstrated outstanding scholarship
and a broad range of superior attributes including honesty, high moral character,
ethics, integrity, initiative, leadership ability, and concern for community and peers.

## **Personal Statement Essay Question**

Use this opportunity to allow the committee to get to know you beyond what is supplied in the application/transcript. Ideas you could write about:

- · Background, identity, interest or talent that is meaningful to you and why.
- · Your call to ministry.
- · Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal and/or spiritual growth or new understanding of yourself.
- · Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback or failure. How did it affect you and your faith? How did you overcome it?

## **Recommendation Letters**

**Three** letters of recommendation required:

- 1. Pastor
- 2. School Advisor/Counselor or Teacher
- 3. Community Leader <u>outside</u> the local church, i.e. employer, coach, etc. (No relatives)
